

Pre-doctoral contract (PhD studentship) in Cancer Immunology and Immunotherapy

Applications are invited for a highly motivated and talented student to conduct a research project leading to a degree of PhD in the Immuno-oncology lab led by **Dr. Asis Palazón** at CIC bioGUNE in Bilbao, Spain.

Current studies are focused on the role of hypoxia on T-cell function and anti-tumor immunity, with a focus on target discovery and drug development.

Requirements of the ideal candidate:

- We are seeking a highly motivated candidate with a top undergraduate profile, BSc or MSc in Immunology, Biochemistry, Molecular Cell Biology or related fields. Previous research experience, a strong background in immunology and experience in FACS and other immune based assays is desirable as well as a keen interest in cancer immunotherapy.
- The candidate is expected to be creative, self-motivated and should be able to demonstrate an ability to work independently.
- To critically appraise the identified literature and provide a systematic review, and to engage in the dissemination of the results of the research.
- Excellent analytical skills, report and technical writing, and computer skills with evidence of organisational and communication skills.
